

Monthly commentary, April 2023

Earnings for the first quarter and the ongoing banking crisis in the US were two major forces influencing financial markets in the month.

The financial markets have so far been surprisingly complacent about the failure of three regional banks in the US. We have reduced our exposure to financials significantly as several of our positions hit price target earlier in the year, and currently have zero exposure to US financials.

Among the strongest performers in the month were Brazilian sugar and ethanol group Sao Martinho and investment company Peugeot Invest, which holds a substantial interest in automaker Stellantis. One of the weakest positions was Canfor Pulp, which exited the fund in the month as the operating footprint has deviated from our base investment thesis.

During the month we also sold out of our positions in South Korean insurance company DB Insurance and Mexican consumer hygiene products company Kimberly Clark de Mexico as both stocks reached our price target.

We have found interesting value elsewhere, and have added a position in UK homebuilder Persimmon, which we believe is trading substantially below its normalised earnings potential and has a solid balance sheet to weather the current depressed operating climate.
